Conversations

Day 1

Luke 8:4-8

Day 2

Luke 8:4-8

Day 3

Luke 8:9-10

Jesus says that stories sometimes help people to understand a difficult idea. Can you think of a time when a story helped you understand something difficult?

Day 4

Luke 8:11-15

Do you think about the Kingdom of God differently after hearing this story? Why or why not?

Day 5

Luke 8:11-15

In the story, the sower wastes a bunch of seeds by throwing them everywhere. How is the good news of God's Kingdom different from seeds? Do you think it is good to share the good news like the sower spread the seeds?
